

Objective of the Lecture

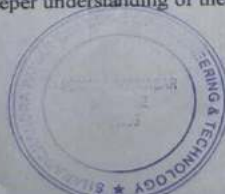

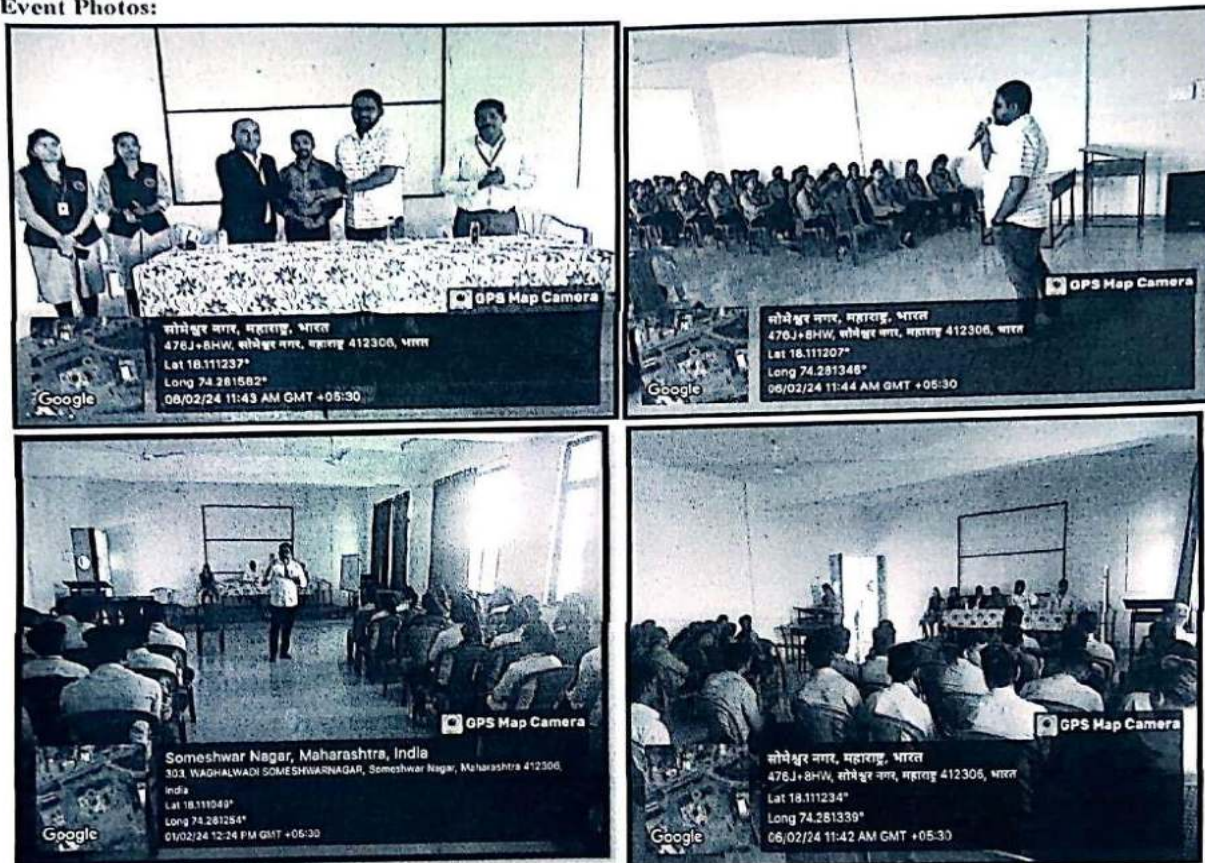
